

District Activity Report

We have improved the District Activity Report to provide you with the level of data you need. In this report you can get a glimpse at overall usage or drill down for more detail on Learning.com activity in your district.

So let's take a look at the District Activity Report.

From your Coordinator Portal, click the Reports drop down in the top menu, then choose district activity report.

Select the time frame you'd like to view activity for then click Get Report to load the data.

Right away you have a high-level overview of your district's activity, a breakdown of that activity by skill and further down, activity by school.

Here we have the number of students active on Learning.com and you can easily see Tech Quest launches which is the EasyTech sequence automatically assigned to each student vs Teacher-Assigned launches.

From here you can print a report of what you see on this page.

You can also type keywords to view high level data and export what you see to a CSV.

But if you want to take a deeper look, click on a School with activity.

Here you can type keywords in the search bar to find something specific or hover over the column headers to see the hamburger icon which allows you to filter within each category.

If a column is filtered, it will have a funnel icon, so be sure to clear the filter if you need to see all data again.

You can also sort ascending or descending by clicking the column header.

And once you've filtered the data you can also print this report or export it to CSV.
